Does more education lower the barriers to social mobility?

An analysis of three birth cohorts

during a period of educational expansion in Brazil

Research in social stratification has long established that the direct effects of social origin on occupational destination are lower for those with higher levels of education. This is known as the compositional effect, through which many see educational expansion as an equalizing force. Recent studies, however, have challenged this position with new evidence showing the opposite. We contribute to this debate by adding the Brazilian case during a period of rapid educational expansion. We estimate the chances of class mobility, status attainment, and the odds of reaching non-manual classes using data from three birth cohorts. Our evidence shows that attaining higher levels of education reduces the origin-destination association only for the older cohort. For the younger cohorts born after educational expansion, mobility chances for the highly educated are no better compared to those with less education. In other words, educational expansion has failed to reduce the direct link between origins and destinations for highly educated Brazilians. We argue that these results reflect the positionality of education. As the educational system expands, the power of the compositional effect to reduce the origin-destination association is seriously eroded.
